

Operation Agile Spear – A Georgian Nightmare

Gameplay Suggestions

For an optimal gameplay experience, we recommend the following adjustments if your computer **has less** than 32GB RAM:

- We recommend rebooting your computer prior to launching DCS and the campaign to optimize memory usage.
- Close all open programs. Right click any open icons on the Taskbar and close them.
 - Hit Ctrl + Alt + Delete > Task Manager > Processes > Apps and close all the open apps.
 - You can go through and try to close unneeded Background Processes although this could make your system unstable.
- In DCS World Options under System, set Civilian Traffic to “Off” or “Min” for computers with less than 32gb of memory.
- In DCS World Options under System, set Raindrops to “Off”.
- While in DCS World Options under Gameplay, you can enable “Easy Communication” if you do not want to configure your radios.
- To allow for clearer audio of other pilots you can slide “In-Cockpit” down to 50%-60% in Options > Audio and make sure “Hear Like In Cockpit” is checked.
- Also, while less realistic you can enable Labels > “Symbol Only” which will create a small one-pixel red dot on your enemies. This will make it easier to visualize and attack enemy forces.
- Feel free to change the armament loadout for each mission prior to takeoff with the:
Lt Alt + ‘ keys.
 - Remember, real-world A-10s do not fly with 3 Mavericks per wing.
 - Try to avoid weighting down the jet with armament. Actual A-10 pilots prefer to fly the jet as lightly as possible to enhance maneuverability.
- If your aircraft becomes damaged you can repair the damage by returning to any Coalition base, shutting down the jet, and initiating the repair with:

“ \ > F8. Ground Crew > F3. Request Repair ”

You may have to ask him twice as the Chief can get quite busy.
- You can Rearm, Refuel, and Repair your jet at the same time (as long as you are parked on a Coalition airbase with the jet shut down).
- Almost all of the information you will need to complete the campaign is on your Kneeboard (just like in a real-world flight). We recommend mapping a button on your HOTAS or throttle for easy in-flight access to the Kneeboard as a reference source.
- On mission start, the aircraft radios will be turned on and set to the starting base frequency. However, you may still use “Easy Comms” if you so desire.

- One last note, you may experience inappropriate behavior by your AI Wingmen during gameplay such as not attacking targets when ordered or just Returning To Base (RTB) without explanation. These are known issues within DCS regarding AI behavior which the DCS team is, as always, attempting to correct. It should not affect your gameplay.
