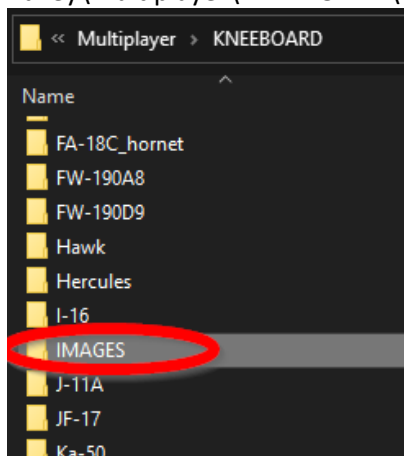


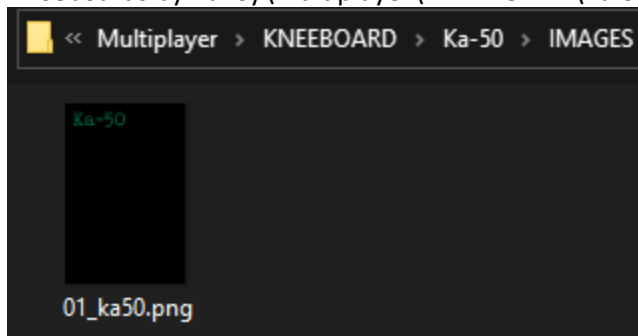
Use the provided templates to quickly and accurately make the folder structure for every DCS module kneeboard. Instructions for Single Player, Personal Kneeboards, and Multiplayer Mission Makers are included.

Instructions for Multiplayer Mission Makers:

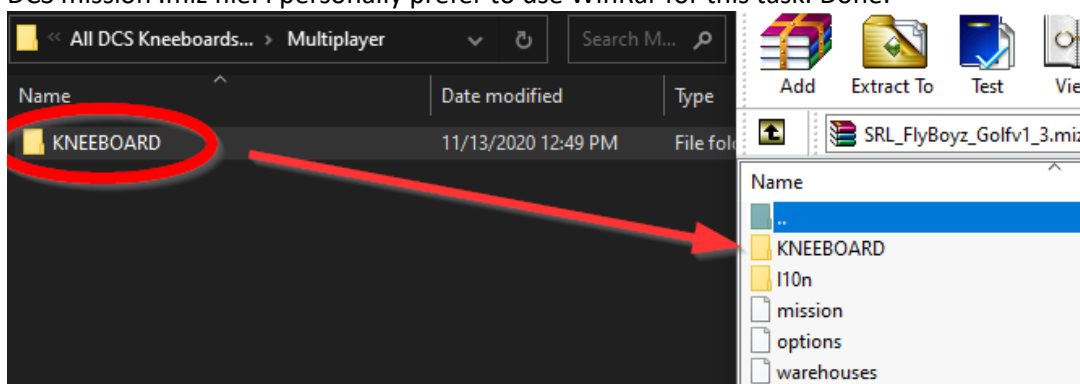
1. Put your Global kneeboard images in the folder called “\All DCS Kneeboards by Bailey\Multiplayer\KNEEBOARD\IMAGES”. Those images will be seen by everyone on the server.



2. Put your aircraft specific kneeboard images in the “\IMAGES” folder of the aircraft that represents the aircraft name. For example, if you have a helicopter FARP image, you may want to put that in “\All DCS Kneeboards by Bailey\Multiplayer\KNEEBOARD\Ka-50\IMAGES”

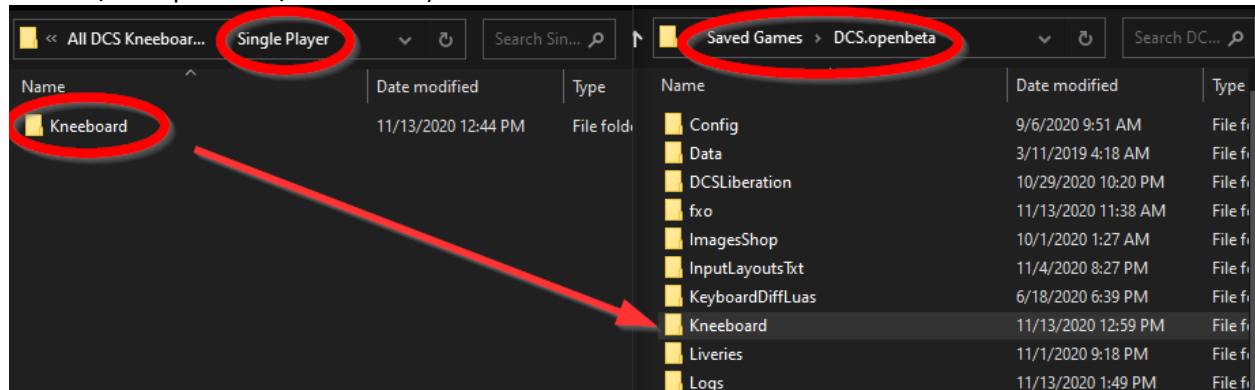


3. Once complete with all of your additions and changes, drag the **entire** “KNEEBOARD” folder into your DCS mission .miz file. I personally prefer to use WinRAR for this task. Done.



Instructions for Single Player or Personal Kneeboards:

1. Navigate to “\All DCS Kneeboards by Bailey\Single Player”.
2. Drag the entire “kneeboard” folder to your DCS Saved Games location (“C:\Users\...\Saved Games\DCS.openbeta\Kneeboard”).



3. Add and delete images from “C:\Users\...\Saved Games\DCS.openbeta\Kneeboard” as you wish.
Done.

TIPS:

-DCS seems to like “.png” files at a 4:6 resolution ratio. Examples include 400x600, 800x1200, and so on.
