

Low level run & Airfield strike

Installation:

Download the zip file, use 7zip or similar to unpack it

The briefing PDF & map should be in there too.

Copy the .miz file to your DCS Missions folder:

C:\Users\User's name\Saved Games\DCS.openbeta (if you're using the DCS OpenBeta)\Missions

If you've got loads of missions, you might want to save it to a sub folder marked 'Harrier' or similar so you can find it more easily.

SHORT BRIEFING – if you really want to just get up & have fun:

Start up your plane. Perhaps let the SEAD harriers take off first so they can deal with threats.

Hit the runway at Beslan and any parked aircraft.

Get home.

FULL BRIEFING:

Situation

The airfield at Beslan is the target today – a low level run through the mountain valleys to maintain surprise for as long as possible. It's likely that hostile planes will launch as soon as you're detected, so stay 500 AGL once in the mountains and follow the route closely.

The location of the IP should line you up with the runway nicely.

Objectives:

1. The runway at Beslan
2. Any parked aircraft

FRIENDLY FORCES:

Air Units:

Springfield flight


Type: Harrier

Freq: 243MHz

Task: Runway and parked aircraft

Ordnance: 10x Mk82 snakeyes, 1x Sidarm, 1x Sidewinder

Notes: Let the SEAD flight hit the defences first while you line up for the runway



Waypoints:

- 1-12. Low level route through the valleys
- 13. IP – approx. 5 miles east of Beslan runway
- 14. Beslan runway threshold
- 15. Entrance to valley route home
- 16. Home plate - Soganlug airfield

Enfield flight

Type: Harrier

Freq: 243MHz

Task: SEAD

Ordnance: 1x Sidearm, 1x Sidewinder, 2x AGM64F, 4x Rockeye

Notes: Let the SEAD flight hit the defences first while you line up for the runway

101 flight

Type: Su27 (Georgian)

Freq: 243MHz

Task: CAP

Notes: will provide cover close to home, but reluctant to cross into Russia

Friendly Bases:

Soganlug. Freq. 139MHz, Chan 25X

Vaziani – Freq. 140MHz, Chan 22X

HOSTILE FORCES

Ground threats:

ZU23s spotted in various locations around the airfield and surrounding towns

SA6 approx. 6KM south of Beslan airfield

SA8s & ZSU23s detected defending the airfield

Airborne Threats:

None, although Mig23s are certain to be scrambled from Beslan and Nalchik (approx. 60KM west of Beslan) once you're spotted.

Bullseye:

Beslan airfield

Time & Weather:

0710, 05 degrees C, wind 124 for 5 knots

Overcast and mist reported in the mountains.
