- Bringing order to the region.
- Eliminate the terrorist nexus inside of Georgia.
- “Capture-or-Kill” High Value Targets and / or War Criminals in the region.

- Provide Overwatch and CAS (if Required) for Romeo-7 (4 x HMMV Gun Trucks).
- Complete tasks as directed by the Operational Commander in the region (Whiplash-1).

AFTER ACTIONS REPORT (AAR)

Mission Two - “Welcome to Suse” Objectives:

- Provide CAS and CASEVAC support for Ground Forces (Voodoo-23 & 24).
- Assist in Capturing or Killing Tango-6 (HVT).
- Complete tasks as directed by the Operational Commander in the region (Whiplash-1).

COMPLETED

2 July 2015 - An inflight emergency (IFE) was declared at Kutaisi Air Base before mission launch for a C-130 (Callsign Mike 74) carrying hazardous cargo. The C-130 crashed on final approach to Kutaisi Air Base, no survivors were reported from the C-130 crew. Mission operations resumed shortly after the IFE incident. Hawg Flight successfully provided CAS for Voodoo-23 & 24 in the Capture-or-Kill mission on HVT “Tango-6.” Hawg Flight neutralized Tango-6 as he attempted to flee the Target AO in a SUV. Positive confirmation that Tango-6 (Abu Ayyub al-Masri) is KIA. In addition, during the operation a F-18 Pilot had to eject in enemy territory. Hawg Flight was tasked with an immediate CSAR mission for the pilot Callsign Dodge 1-1. Hawg Flight with the assistance of UAV assets located the crash site and Dodge 1-1. Enemy forces attempted to infiltrate the crash site and Dodge 1-1’s location. Hawg Flight successfully neutralized enemy forces threatening Dodge 1-1. CSAR assets successfully rescued Dodge 1-1 during the operation. No further action or recommendations required. ///END OF REPORT///

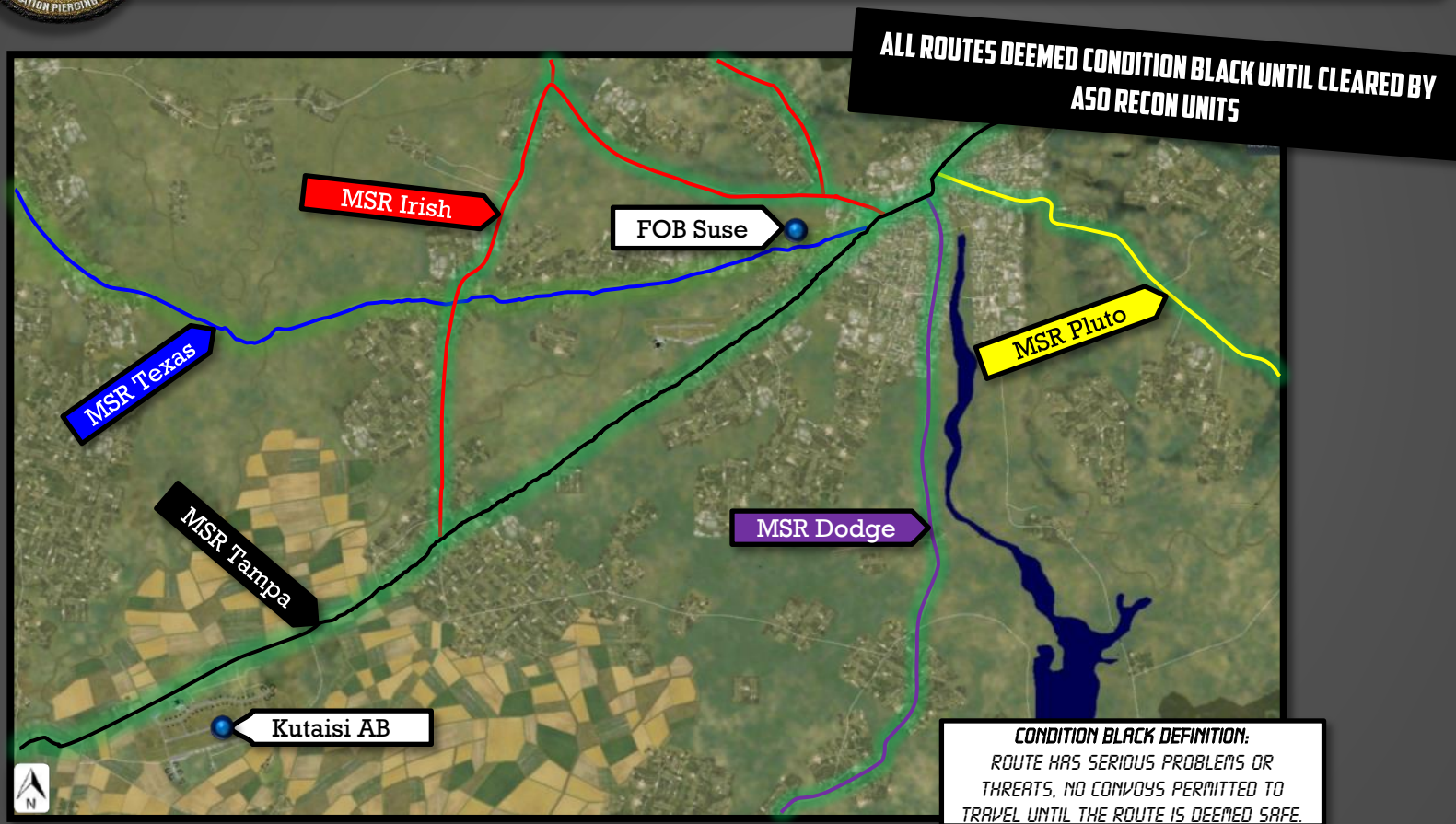

Complete tasks as directed by the Operational Commander in the region (Whiplash-1).



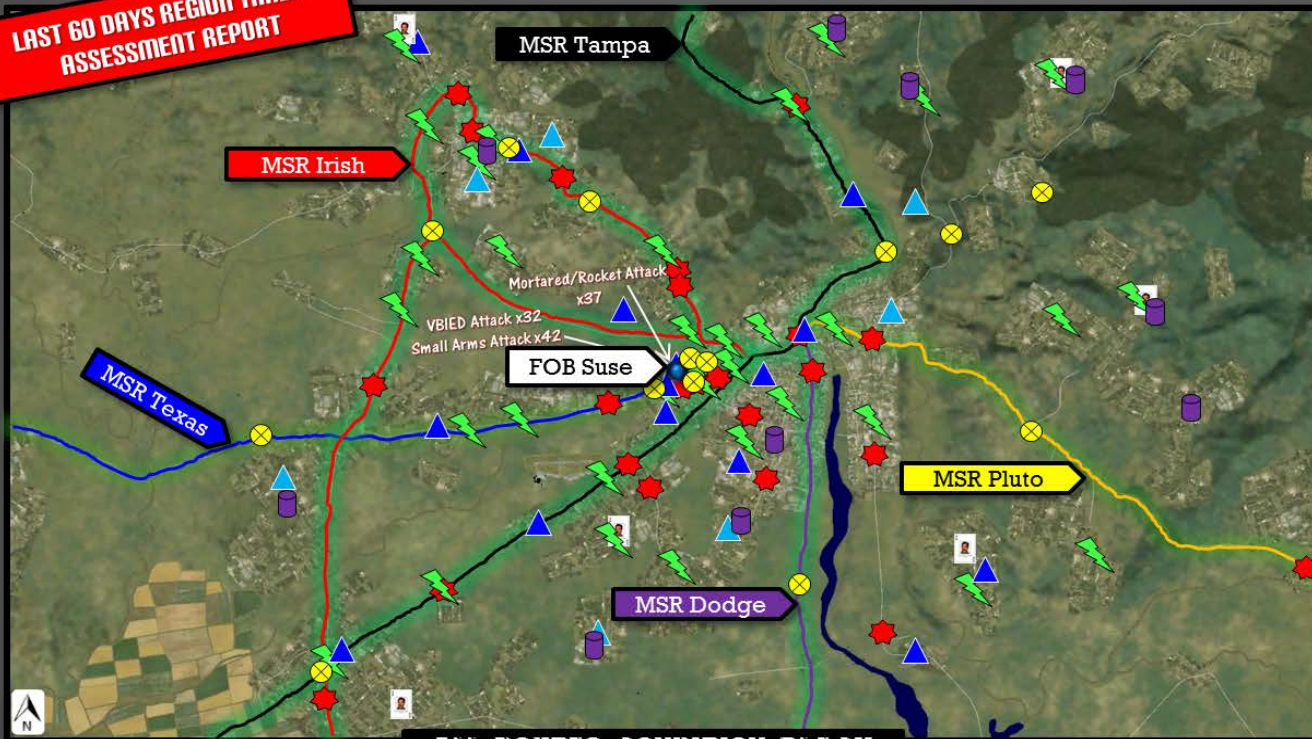
MAJOR SUPPLY ROUTES AROUND KUTAISI

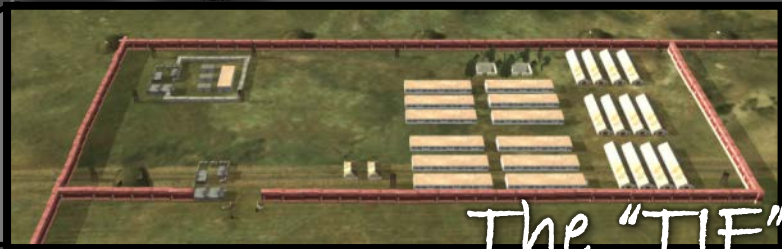

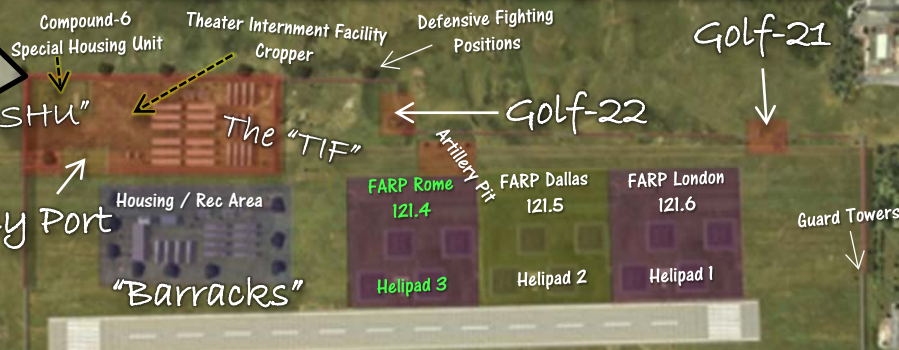
