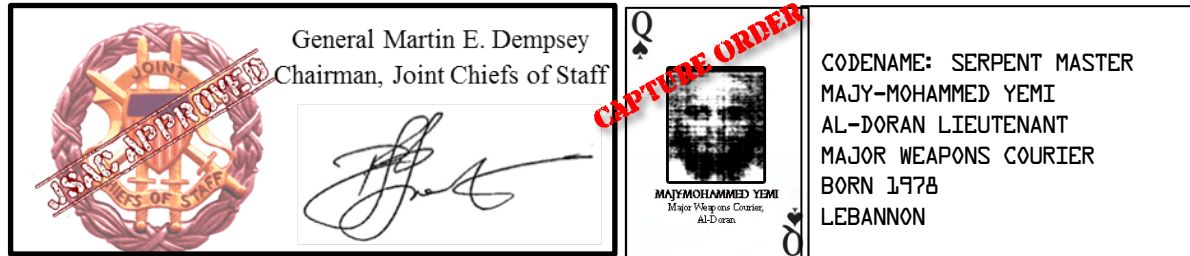


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(TS) **OPERATIONS ORDER 046-2015-07:**

(TS) **Joint Chiefs of Staff Authorization: Capture Authorization Order for Majy-Mohammed Yemi, Codename: Serpent Master.**



(TS) **Task Organization:** United States Navy Special DEVGRU, SEAL TEAM-6, US Army 75th Ranger Regiment, 2nd Battalion members, AH-64D pilots, and USAF JSOC A-10C Warthog pilots composing of approximately 50 enlisted and officer personnel will be identified with their respective Callsigns; Rawhide-1, Chalk-1, Chalk-2, Reaper, and Hawg 1-1. All personnel will be tasked by the Ground Commander outlined in this order. Small arms, demolition, and heavy weapons are authorized for use in this mission. Close Air Support (CAS) will be on-station consisting of fixed wing assets. All coalition ground team members proficiency levels are expert. Additional Special Forces assets from the Coalition can be utilized if needed. Back-up forces from Forward Operation Bases (FOB)'s and Airbases in the region may be called upon by the Ground Commander if the situation dictates. Tactical dominance, air assault, ambush, and Military Operation in Urban Terrain (MOUT) will be vital to mission success.

I. Situation

(U) Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999) and 1989 (2011) concerning Al-Doran and associated individuals and entities:

(U) Al-Doran in Iraq was listed on **18 October 2004** pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 16 of resolution 1526 (2004) as being associated with Al-Doran for “participating in the financing, planning, facilitating, preparing or perpetrating of acts or activities by, in conjunction with, under the name of, on behalf or in support of”, “supplying, selling or transferring arms and related materiel to” or “otherwise supporting acts or activities of Abu-Mohammed Zeri and Al-Doran” (QE.A.4.01.).

(TS) Rebel and terrorist forces have occupied key cities within the Country of Georgia. Al-Doran, SPIA, and other key terrorist organizations have flocked to the region to regroup, retrain, and strategize to take over Europe and spread their Islamic ideals to the world. A small United Nations peacekeeping force was ordered into the country under Resolution 435.1 to establish a Secure Zone and No-Fly Zone in the southern and central region of Georgia. The UN forces under strict rules of engagement were quickly overtaken by the rebel and terrorist forces in the region, and were forced to retreat. Coalition Forces led by the United States are tasked in bringing order back to the region, eliminate the terrorist nexus, and Capture or Kill High Value Targets / War Criminals who have engulfed the region. Enemy resistance has been very strong, and Intelligence Reports suggest many of the rebel and terrorist groups are receiving financial and supply assistance from Iran, Syria, IIPR, and possibly senior members of other Middle Eastern countries.

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(TS) The Chairman Joint Chiefs of Staff has ordered the Capture mission for Majy-Mohammed Yemi, Codename: Serpent Master. Intelligence captured from a recent intelligence gathering operation at grid coordinates; LM 32438 73426, Signals Intelligence (SIGINT), and other Human Intelligence (HUMINT) identified a possible location for Yemi. Yemi is an Al-Doran Lieutenant and major weapons courier for the Al-Doran terrorist organization. The operation is to capture Yemi alive to disrupt weapon movements in the AO, and to gather additional intelligence for future operations. Yemi is suspected to be located at an enemy compound near the village of Ahalsopeli at grid coordinates; LM 30286 86545.

(TS) Intelligence gathered at the target area; the village of Ahalsopeli grid coordinates; LM 31239 86247 indicates multiple portable surface-to-air missiles personnel, anti-aircraft positions, and light-to-heavy armor units throughout the village. Many of the anti-air units are located atop rooftops throughout the village.

A. Enemy Forces

(U) 1. Weather conditions in the target area of operations (AO) are calm with high temperatures in the 80's. Cloud conditions are light to medium. Winds are calm at 1-2 kmh at ground level. Moonlight illumination is 1/4 strength within the next 24-48 hours.

(S) 2. Terrain: The target AO is an inlet area located on the Tkibuli Reservoir. The area contains heavily forested area, urban terrain, and variable elevation.

(S) 3. Identification of enemy forces: Al-Doran and Rebel forces will range from semi-skilled militia fighters in mixed military gear, to highly skilled infantry and anti-tank personnel with full body armor and light to heavy weapons. Anti-aircraft, armored assets, and motorized infantry units have been spotted at the target AO. Fixed wing Air Support for the enemy is not likely. However, rotary assets are possible.

(S) 4. Location(s): Enemy forces have been spotted by reconnaissance assets occupying Ahalsopeli, and adjoining villages.

(S) 5. Activity: Enemy forces are occupying and defending the village at Ahalsopeli. Morale is suspected to be high for the enemy force and surrender is not likely.

(S) 6. Strength: Exact strength of the enemy force is unknown. Expect squad and platoon size troop levels throughout the village. Enemy equipment ranges from anti-aircraft units, small arms, crew-served weapons, heavy machine guns, anti-tank weapons, and light armor. The enemy force is believed to have the capability to reinforce the village within 30-60 minutes with platoon to company size units.

(U) 7. Probable course(s) of action when the enemy is contacted is to Defend-and-Hold their established areas. Yemi may try to escape, watch for likely escape routes around the area. Suicide bombers may be present, and hidden IED's are likely to be present around the compound. Surrender is highly unlikely, enemy forces are highly trained and highly loyal to Yemi.

B. Friendly Forces

(S) 1. Mission and concept of next higher unit:

(S) Chalk-1 (US Army, 75th Rangers, 2nd Battalion, SF Unit): (Callsign: Chalk-1)

1 x Team Leader (with laser designator), 6 x Operators, 4 x Grenadier, 2 x Medic, 2 x Support Gunner (optional sniper), 4 x Explosives Expert

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(S) Chalk-2 (US Army, 75th Rangers, 2nd Battalion, SF Unit): (Callsign: Chalk-2)
1 x Team Leader (with laser designator), 6 x Operators, 4 x Grenadier, 2 x Medic, 2 x Support Gunner, 4 x Sniper / Recon

(S) Rawhide-1 (US Navy, Seal Team Six, SF Unit): (Callsign: Rawhide-1)
1 x Team Leader (with laser designator), 8 x Operators, 1-2 x Grenadier, 3 x Support Gunner (optional sniper), MWD Team, 2 x Combat Medic

(S) Rawhide-2 (US Navy, Seal Team Six, SF Unit): (Callsign: Rawhide-2)
1 x Team Leader (with laser designator), 8 x Operators, 1-2 x Grenadier, 3 x Support Gunner (optional sniper), MWD Team, 2 x Combat Medic

(S) Hawg Flight (Close Air Support): (Callsign: Hawg 1-1)
4 x A-10C pilots (Hawg Flight) (Flight Lead): (Hawg 1-1)

(S) Reaper Flight (Close Air Support): (Callsign: Reaper 1-1)
2 x AH-64D pilots (Reaper Flight) (Flight Lead): (Reaper 1-1)

(TS) 2. Location and planned actions of units; Rawhide-1 & 2 are tasked with the capture of Majy-Mohammed Yemi, Codename: Serpent Master. Chalk-1 & 2 are tasked with setting up a perimeter at the village of Ahalsopeli. Chalk-1 forces are also tasked with destroying a bridge to the inlet village of Ahalsopeli. Units providing fire support as directed: Hawg Flight (CAS)

C. Attachments/Detachments

(U) Attachment: None

II. Mission

(TS) The immediate Capture of Majy-Mohammed Yemi, Codename: Serpent Master. Captured enemy combatants will be relocated to FOB SUSE as enemy prisoners of war (EPW)'s. Search for intelligence at the enemy compound. Destruction of the compound will commence with at EZFIL of Rawhide forces.

(S) Chalk-1 is responsible for securing the East sector of Ahalsopeli.

(S) Chalk-1 is responsible for destroying a bridge located at the East sector of Ahalsopeli.

(S) Chalk-2 is responsible for securing the North sector of Ahalsopeli.

(S) Chalk-2 is responsible for gathering intelligence and conduct reconnaissance for the Ahalsopeli AO.

(TS) Rawhide-1 & 2 are responsible for capturing Yemi (Codename: Joker) at an enemy compound SE of the village Ahalsopeli.

(S) Hawg Flight is responsible for CAS for ground forces.

(S) Reaper Flight is responsible for CAS for ground forces.

(S) Hellraiser Flight is responsible for inserting Chalk-1 & 2 forces into the Target AO.

(S) Vulture Flight is responsible inserting Rawhide-1 & 2 forces into the Target AO.

III. Execution

Intent

(TS) The immediate Capture of Majy-Mohammed Yemi, Codename: Serpent Master. Secondary: Search for intelligence at the enemy compound.

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A. Concept of the Operation:

(TS) The operation will be conducted at dusk. Hellraiser-1 & 2 (2 x UH-60) will move out from FOB SUSE transporting Chalk-1 and Chalk-2 to a holding area SW of the target AO. Vulture Flight (2 x CH-53) will move out from FOB Suse transporting Rawhide-1 & 2 to a holding pattern South of the Target AO. Reaper-1 & 2 (2 x AH-64D) will move out from FOB Suse and hold with Hellraiser Flight until Hawg Flight is inside the Target AO. All forces will hold until Hawg Flight is overhead at their established WP2 (seal6). Once Hawg Flight is within range of the Target AO, Reaper flight will be cleared to engage enemy forces at the Target AO. Hawg Flight will engage enemy forces at the Target AO.

(TS) Once all major enemy anti-air, armor, and ground forces are neutralized at the Target AO, Hellraiser Flight will be cleared into the Target AO. Hellraiser-1 will insert Chalk-1 East of the Target AO at a roadway intersection at grid location; LM 31925 84737. Hellraiser-2 will insert Chalk-2 North of the Target AO on a roadway at grid location; LM 32248 88155. Chalk-1 will move West towards the Target AO and plant demolition charges along a main bridge grid location; LM 31571 85085. Chalk-1 will detonate the bridge charges once at their rally point in their target AO. Chalk-2 will move South to their rally point inside the Target AO and setup reconnaissance for friendly forces in the AO. Chalk-1 and Chalk-2 will setup a defensive perimeter around the Target AO to prevent possible follow-on enemy forces and/or escape of Yemi.

(TS) Once Chalk-1 and Chalk-2 have completed their taskings, and are standing by at their designated rally points; Vulture Flight will be cleared into the AO to insert Rawhide-1 & 2 to Yemi's suspected compound located at grid coordinates; LM 30286 86545.

(TS) Rawhide-1 will sweep and clear the compound searching for Yemi. Rawhide-2 will setup a defensive perimeter around the compound. Rawhide units will conduct intelligence gathering operations at the compound once Yemi is secure. Vulture flights will EZFIL Rawhide units once operations at the compound are completed. The compound will be destroyed via timed demolition charges once Rawhide units are EXFIL'd from the area.

(S) Chalk-1 and Chalk-2 will rendezvous at the center of Ahalsopeli for EXFIL via Outlaw 4-2 (1 x CH-47) once Rawhide's mission is complete.

B. Tasks to Maneuver Units

(S) Hellraiser Flight is tasked with any search and rescue or support for DURESS calls from friendly forces in the village. Always announce when crossing into another teams AOR or Sector to avoid friendly fire.

C. Tasks to Combat Support Units

(S) CAS Flights will orbit the area and provide CAS as directed by ground force commanders.

D. Coordinating Instructions

(S) Team leaders will coordinate what movement speed, type of formation, and rules of engagement for their respective members. Whiplash-1 may dictate diversion in plans depending on the battlefield situation.

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IV. Service Support

(S) Whiplash-1 will task CSAR assets from FOB Suse with CASEVAC transport if required.

A. General

(S) RV FOB Suse with CASEVAC patients.

B. Material and Services

(S) Contact FOB Suse Command Post for supply needs.

C. Medical Evacuation:

(S) Whiplash-1 will task FOB Suse forces with resupply drops and CASEVAC transport if required.

D. Personnel:

(S) EPW's will be transported to FOB SUSE and held at the TIF Cropper.

E. Miscellaneous:

(S) Special equipment. Biometrics scanner.

(S) Captured equipment. Any enemy equipment which is captured can be used or destroyed depending on mission needs.

V. Command & Signal

A. Command

(S) (Whiplash-1) has overall command of the region. Whiplash-1 has operational command of this mission. Team leads for all enemy forces will command their teams to accomplish the mission.

B. Signal

(S) Main Communications will be portable and long range encrypted radio signals. Ground teams must meet with the COMSEC NCOIC to ensure CCI keys are current before mission start. (Will be present at airstrip on FOB SUSE)

(U) Loss of communications:

(S) Deploy WHITE smoke if in need of immediate help, with no communications. Closest friendly unit will backup team in duress. Inter-personal communications devices and manual hand and arm signals should be used by team for movements.



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
