

DCS F-86F Sabre VoiceAttack by Bailey v1.0

Intro

Hello and welcome to Bailey's VoiceAttack Profile for the DCS F-86F Sabre! This is the README. Thank you for taking a look-see. Please make sure to configure your key binds to what I have provided in the download files (Keyboard_F86FvX.diff.lua). It is up to you to make sure you have the most amount of fun with this profile. Import those keybinds! With just less than 900 unique commands, the sky is the limit. Use as many or as little as you like.

How to Install

1. Extract the file you downloaded with your personal flavor of zip software (winzip, winrar, etc.).
2. Open Voice Attack and Import the file called 'Bailey F-86F Sabre vX.vax'. The 'X' denotes the version numbers. The higher the number, the more recent the version.
3. Open DCS and go to the Controls menu.
4. Ensure that you are in the "F-86F Real" bindings (check the top left dropdown menu).
5. Click any box in the Keyboard column.
6. Click "Load Profile" in the upper right of the menu.
7. Navigate to and select the file called 'Keyboard_F86Fv1.diff.lua' that was in the download, then press OK.
8. Yay! You did it!

How to understand VoiceAttack and this VA Profile

To get the full benefit and understanding of this VAP, you will need to know how commands are made and written in VoiceAttack. Please search for and read the "Dynamic command sections" in the VoiceAttack readme. Sure, you can use this profile without having read it, but you will get so much more out of it if you do! From this point forward, I will assume you have read the page or two of information about dynamic command sections. If you want to use this VAP with another VAP, take a look at "Global Profiles" in the readme too.

Crew Chief Commands

These commands can be used on the ground while at a friendly airport.

"chief, request repair"

"chief, rearm and refuel"

"chief, turn off the ground power"

"chief, turn on the ground power"

Radio Commands

This profile features automatic UHF channel tuning. You will have to reset it each time you get in the jet, but its easy.

1. Say "Reset Sabre radios"
2. Wait a little.
3. Done!

Here are some examples of commands that you can use to tune the radio. The UHF radio has 18 presets, plus Guard. Many of the DCS Caucasus airports are pre-configured in the radio, assuming the mission maker did not change them. If an airport does not have a UHF radio channel preset, the radio will be set to guard (aka, channel zero).

"tune Batumi tower"

"tune channel 15"

"UHF next channel"

"UHF last channel"

VoiceAttack does not know what your DCS radios are tuned to. It keeps track of what it *should* be. If you ever find the need to reset the radios in flight, you can use the "Reset Sabre radios" again.

The F-86F Sabre only has 1 radio.

Say "Comms" to bring up the DCS comm menu.

You can say "F [1..12]" to use the F Menu to talk to AI, for example.

Kneeboard Commands

Use these commands to, well, command the kneeboard.

"Show/hide/toggle kneeboard"

"kneeboard next/previous"

"next/previous page"

"kneeboard mark"

"kneeboard glance"

"kneeboard where are we"

Cockpit Commands

For your ease of use, I have made some Cockpit commands. Look into the VA profile to see more and feel free to add more of your own! You can also export the .vap to .html an make your own list. See the VA readme for more info.

ADF antenna	ADF band [up;down]	ADF [CW;comp;cont;loop;off]
ADF voice	ADF volume [down;up]	ADF mute
battery on	[cage;uncage] sight	speed brake [in;retract;out;]
UHF [adf;off;transmit receive]	UHF transmit receive guard	UHF volume [up;down]
canopy [close;open]	compass light [on;off]	emergency fuel [on;off]
exterior lighting [bright;dim]	fuel gauge on	gear [up;down]
generator on	IFF [low;norm;off;standby]	jettison everything
labs [on;off]	labs [labs;changeover;a4]	labs [cage;uncage]
landing lights [on;off;retract]	manual pip [bomb;normal]	missile [left and right;right]
missile salvo	missile safe launch	pitot heat [on;off;toggle]
position [light flash;off;steady]	[next;last] rocket	

Macro Commands

This Profile contains every single DCS F-86F Sabre action Eagle Dynamics has to offer as a Voice Attack Command. This gives you the ability to make commands and macros of your own. The possibilities are nearly limitless. Make sure to read the Voice Attack Readme so that you can use your time wisely and get ahead of the curve. Use your imagination! Here are some that I made up. You can do it too! These ones are pretty fun, if you ask me. Try making a “prepare for landing” command, for example.

“give me guns”

“give me bombs”

“give me missiles”

“give me rockets”
