

## **"SAFE-NORTH" – TACTICAL MAP**

In order to improve the coordination of ground and air forces, participants can make use of the tactical-map.

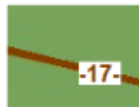
This map is based on high-resolution frames from the relevant area of operation from the DCS map, with the addition of marking of roads, road bridges and towns in a manner which makes the dialog between the fighting forces easier.

### **MAP MARKINGS AND METHOD:**

- Roads:

Label example:



- Road-bridges

Example:



In the above example, the label consist of "B" (for Bridge), "14" is the road number on which the bridge is located, and "2" is a serial number (meaning there's at least one other bridge on the same road, which would be labeled B14-01)

- Populated area (city, village etc')

Example:



In the above example, the town labeling means:

- "P" – stands for "population"
- "GH11" is the grid sector
- "5" is a serial number starting at the North-Western corner of the given grid.

Below is an example of a small portion of the tactical map, centered on GH23. Note the marking of two of the operation's objectives: enemy outposts "Bravo" and "Charlie".
