- Provide CAS to Ground Forces in the region if requested.
- Complete tasks as directed by the Operational Commander in the region (Whiplash-1).



AFTER ACTIONS REPORT – MISSION 11 – GHOSTS OF ANACONDA

AFTER ACTIONS REPORT (AAR)

COMPLETED

Mission Eleven - "Ghosts of Anaconda" Objectives:

- Provide immediate support for friendly forces under duress in the Mestia AO.
- Provide CAS for friendly forces in the AO.
- Complete tasks as directed by the Operational Commander in the region (Whiplash-1).

1 November 2015 - Hawg Flight departed Kutaisi AB and made contact with Mega 4-5 for On-Call CAS. Hawg Flight prosecuted multiple targets threatening the two crashsites in the Mesita AO. Hawg Flight was cleared HOT on the enemy base camp in Mestia. Hawg Flight successfully destroyed major enemy forces at the base camp. Savior 2-1 (CSAR) was cleared into the two crashsites by Mega 4-5. During the rescue operation heavy enemy artillery attacked the two crashsites. A Georgian Special Forces Brigade Recon Team spotted the artillery units and contacted Hawg Flight for CAS. Hawg Flight neutralized the enemy artillery units. CASEVAC of the two crashsites was successful. Remaining members of Task Force Mountain conducted intelligence gathering at the enemy base camp. Coalition Forces took several casualties during the operation. No further action or recommendations required. ///END OF REPORT///

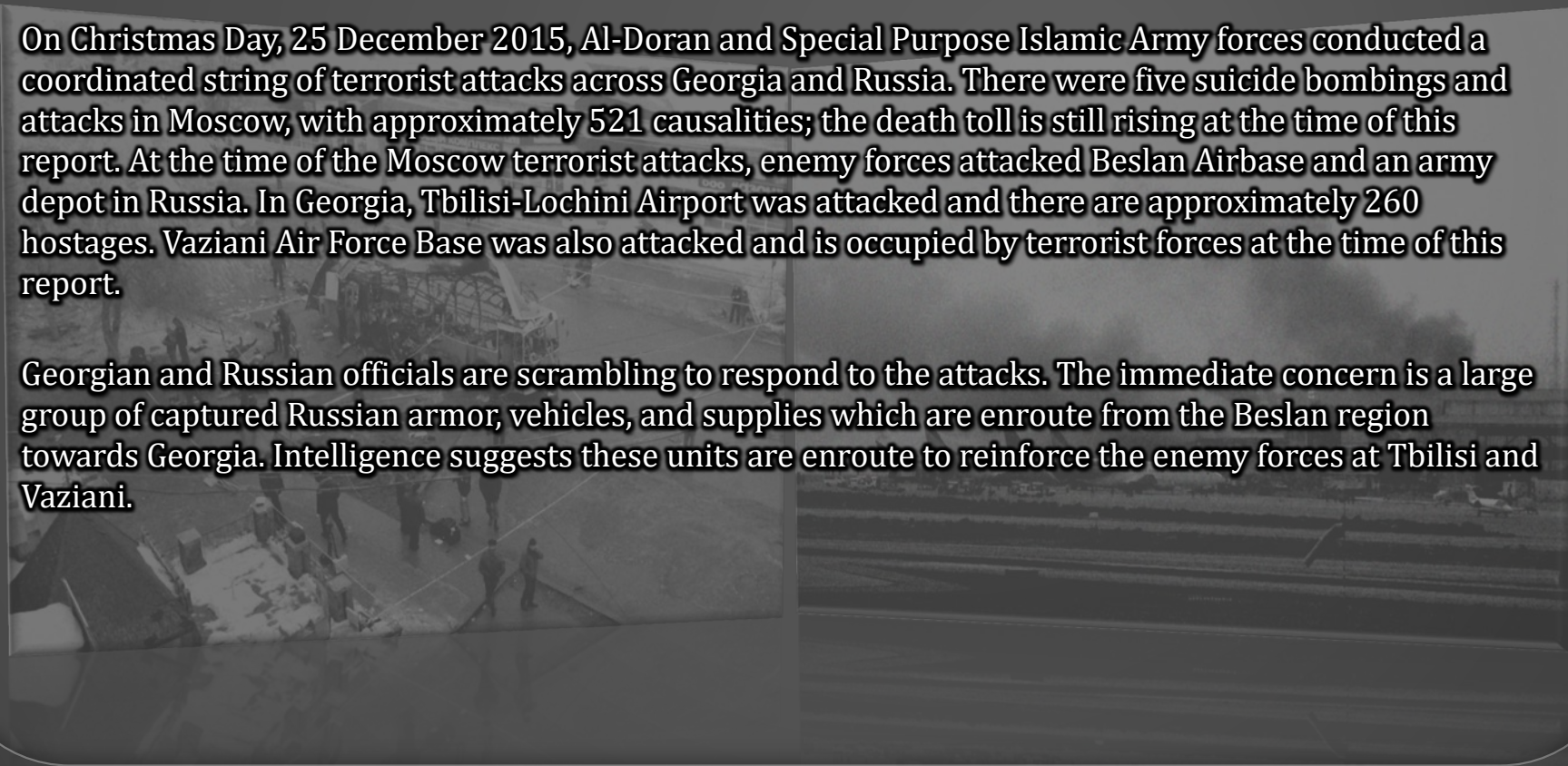


ADDITIONAL INTELLIGENCE – TERRORIST ATTACK ALERT

CONFIRMED INTELLIGENCE

On Christmas Day, 25 December 2015, Al-Doran and Special Purpose Islamic Army forces conducted a coordinated string of terrorist attacks across Georgia and Russia. There were five suicide bombings and attacks in Moscow, with approximately 521 casualties; the death toll is still rising at the time of this report. At the time of the Moscow terrorist attacks, enemy forces attacked Beslan Airbase and an army depot in Russia. In Georgia, Tbilisi-Lochini Airport was attacked and there are approximately 260 hostages. Vaziani Air Force Base was also attacked and is occupied by terrorist forces at the time of this report.

Georgian and Russian officials are scrambling to respond to the attacks. The immediate concern is a large group of captured Russian armor, vehicles, and supplies which are enroute from the Beslan region towards Georgia. Intelligence suggests these units are enroute to reinforce the enemy forces at Tbilisi and Vaziani.

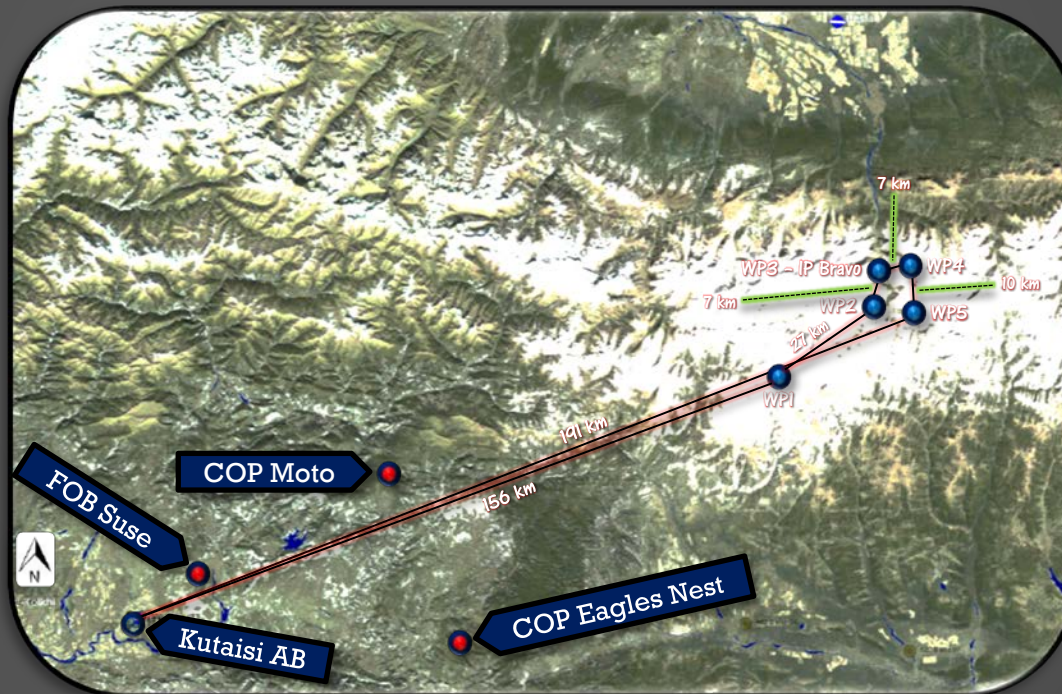
