

DCS AJS37 Viggen VoiceAttack by Bailey v1.0

Intro

Hello and welcome to Bailey's VoiceAttack Profile for the DCS AJS37 Viggen! This is the READMEE. Thank you for taking a look-see. Please make sure to configure your key binds to what I have provided in the files you downloaded (Keyboard_AJS37ViggenVX.diff.lua). Heatblur did not pre-define most of them, so it is up to you to make sure you have the most amount of fun with this profile. Bind those keys! This VA Profile is not as complex as the Viggen itself. I hope it will make your time in the Viggen much more enjoyable. Take your time, learn the aircraft, and use the voice commands that you want to use to supplement how you fly. With practice, this VAP will be second nature.

How to Install

1. Extract the file you downloaded with your personal flavor of zip software (winzip, winrar, etc.).
2. Open Voice Attack and Import the file called 'Bailey AJS37 Viggen vX.vax'. The 'X' denotes the version number. The higher the number, the more recent the version.
3. Open DCS and go to the Controls menu.
4. Ensure that you are in the "AJS37" bindings (check the top left dropdown menu).
5. Click any box in the Keyboard column.
6. Click "Load Profile" in the upper right of the menu.
7. Navigate to and select the file called 'Keyboard_AJS37ViggenVX.diff.lua' that was in the download, then press OK.
8. Yay! You did it!

How to understand VoiceAttack and this VA Profile

To get the full benefit and understanding of this VAP, you will need to know how commands are made and written in VoiceAttack. Please search for and read the "Dynamic command sections" in the VoiceAttack readme. Sure, you can use this profile without having read it, but you will get so much more out of it if you do! From this point forward, I will assume you have read the page or two of information about dynamic command sections. If you want to use this VAP with another VAP, take a look at "Global Profiles" in the readme too. There are times when a switch in DCS may not have discrete ON or OFF keybinds. In these cases, use common sense when you say, "Gear up", "Gear down", or "Gear toggle", for example. This VA profile does not directly track the state of your switches (or anything for that matter) in DCS. Please use common sense.

How to Install the Kneeboard VA Reference Cards

1. Locate the AJS37 Viggen folder you downloaded, copy the entire folder called "Kneeboard", and put it into "C:\Users\YOURNAME\Saved Games\DCS.VERSION"
2. Start a mission and have fun!

Please take some time to take a look at the kneeboard reference cards. They contain most of the commands you will use for a variety of missions and scenarios. My technique is that while I am on the ground at the airport, I flip through all kneeboard pages to make sure the waypoints are correct, the QFE is correct, and that I know which commands I may need during the mission. Seriously, take a look at the kneeboard cards.

Kneeboard Commands

Use these commands to, well, command the kneeboard.

“[Show;hide;toggle;] kneeboard”

“kneeboard [next;previous]”

“[next;previous] page”

“kneeboard mark”

“kneeboard glance”

“kneeboard where are we”

Crew Chief Commands

These commands can be used on the ground while at a friendly airport.

“Chief, request repair”

“Chief, request rearm and refuel”

“Chief, turn off the ground power”

“Chief, turn on the ground power”

“Chief, ground crew”

“Chief, let’s get this party started!”

Radio Commands

Unfortunately, the Viggen does not have manually tunable radios like some other aircraft. Due to the difference in the way the binds interact with the radio knobs, discrete frequency tuning is not available. But, you can still use this VoiceAttack profile to tune the preset radios!

“tune channel [0..9]”

“tune special [1..3]”

“tune group [1..20] [0..9]”

“tune TILS channel [1..20]”

“tune TILS channel auto”

Commands for using the DCS Radio system are as follows. Use the commands “F1” thru “F12” to navigate the DCS Radio menus.

“comms” - brings up the comms menu

“comms atc” - brings up the ATC menu

“comms local atc” - brings up the ATC menu for the closest ATC. Very useful when already at the airport

“comms wingman” - brings up the wingman menu

“comms flight” - brings up the flight menu

“comms [f10; special]” – brings up the F10 comms menu if your mission has one

Macro Commands

This Profile contains almost every single DCS AJS37 Viggen action Heatblur has to offer as a Voice Attack Command. This gives you the ability to make commands and macros of your own. The possibilities are nearly limitless. Make sure to read the Voice Attack Readme so that you can use your time wisely and get ahead of the curve. Use your imagination! Here are some that I made up. You can do it too! These ones are pretty fun, if you ask me. Try making a command called “all lights on”, for example.

"Chief, lets get this party started" - executes autostart and brings up the rearm menu

"Prepare for landing" - does a lot of stuff that gets you ready to land

"fence out" - safes and resets the weapon system and puts the plane in NAV mode

"open chucks guide" - I used this one a lot :)

"give me rockets;missiles;mavs;RB05s;etc" - selects the requested weapon and sets all the switches for you to be able to unsafe and fire the weapon without thinking twice

BONUS: How to Install the Pilot Kneeboard Mod

You have the option to have your virtual DCS Viggen pilot wear two kneeboards at all times. I have provided a way to change them to any VA kneeboard card you wish. This section is for experienced modders who are comfortable and familiar with photoshop, DDS, and modding DCS in general. The steps are easy, but the knowledge behind them is a little too winded for this READMEE. If there is a lot of demand from those not as experienced, I may be able to help out and provide easy options for everyone.

1. Locate the AJS37 Viggen folder you downloaded, copy the entire folder called "Liveries", and put it into "C:\Users\YOURNAME\Saved Games\DCS.VERSION"
2. Open "C:\Users\YOURNAME\Saved Games\DCS.VERSION\Liveries\AJS37cockpit\Bailey Viggen VoiceAttack\VIG_Pilot_Maps.psd"
3. While in the .psd, toggle the desired kneeboard reference cards via the photoshop layers panel.
4. Save as DDS DXT5. Save the .psd. Exit photoshop.
5. Launch DCS. Go to Options > Special > AJS37 > Customized Cockpit and select "Bailey Viggen VoiceAttack"
6. Start a mission and have fun! Don't forget to say "pilot toggle"!
